

## **EMC Associate Teacher Posts**

Exciting opportunity for teachers to share and develop their expertise

EMC is looking to recruit a small number of English and/ or Media teachers to the post of *EMC* Associate Teacher for the 2025/26 academic year to help inform our work. A payment of £600 will be attached to the post, to be paid at the end of the academic year.

You will meet regularly with the EMC team to advise about key issues in the classroom. In return, we will provide you and your department with access to EMC resources.

We will establish exact expectations of your role after recruitment, depending on your areas of expertise. We will recruit teachers who meet the following criteria:

- Work in departments that draw on EMC's resources and CPD
- Work in departments with a commitment to dialogic, creative practices
- Are based in England's state sector
- Teach some KS3 English classes.

We expect all associate teachers as a minimum to:

- Attend two full day meetings / training sessions at EMC outside of term time (travel paid)
- Meet with EMC online once per half-term
- Share student work (with permission)
- Engage in at least one focused project that draws on EMC approaches and/or resources
- Act as ambassadors for FMC's work.

In addition to providing us with advice and information, we would be interested in recruiting teachers who can provide access to their classroom (with permission; all EMC staff DBS checked).

We welcome applications from teachers from traditionally under-represented groups. We also welcome applications from teachers in the early years of their careers.

Please send a letter of application no more than 500 words long, outlining:

- your teaching experience
- your experience of EMC resources and/or CPD
- your particular interests and expertise in relation to curriculum and pedagogy
- what you would bring to the post
