



EMC Associate Teacher Posts

We'd love to work with you!

The English and Media Centre is looking to recruit a small number of English teachers to the post of **EMC Associate Teacher** for the 2026/27 academic year to help inform our work. This is a role that you will undertake alongside your responsibilities as a classroom teacher, with a payment of £300 attached.

You will provide the EMC team with advice and information about key issues in English teaching. In return, we will provide you and your department with access to EMC resources and training.

We are looking to recruit teachers working in the state sector with classes that follow the 11-16 curriculum and, if you are successful, will require you to focus on **creative-critical writing** in your work with us. We will be interested in exploring other aspects of your practice as well.

We expect associate teachers as a minimum to:

- Attend at least one full day session at EMC outside of term time (travel paid)
- Host an EMC team member for a morning or full day in their school
- Meet with EMC and other Associate Teachers online once per term
- Meet with a designated member of the EMC team once per term, either in-person or in your school
- Share student work (with permission)
- Act as ambassadors for EMC's work.

There may also be opportunities to contribute to EMC courses and teacher conferences, either online or in-person.

We are looking for teachers who share EMC's vision for teaching and are based in a school that is open to dialogic, creative practice.

We welcome applications from teachers from traditionally under-represented groups.

There is no need to include references at this point, though we would advise you to consult with a senior leader about the practicalities of taking on this role before applying.
